

#### Quick Start

#### Installation



- Mark the position of holes to drill on the wall using the provided template. The related holes on the box are located at the fours corners.

Warning: do not place screws anywhere else in the box, This may void the garanty.

#### MANUAL mode





When wiring is completed and power set:


- 1- Press the "MANU" push button. the orange LED then lights steadily.
- 2- Check the rotation of the motor using the command device. The "O/O" LED will light when opening, the "F/C" LED will light when closing.

WARNING: there is no auto-stop in MANUAL mode. Any former stop point has been erased.

### PROGRAMMING mode: end position stop points setting.







- 4- Release the command device switch as soon as the pool is fully covered.
- 5- When needed, rewind the cover using the command device, then unroll the cover again.





6- Press the "PROG" push button again to complete programming. Then the blue LED turns off and the control changes to AUTO-STOP mode.

## LEDs color code














- When powering the control, the red and green LEDs blink shortly.



- When the "CAPTEUR/SENSOR" green LED remains shut off or lights fixed, it means a motor sensor failure. After 3 seconds the "DEFAUT/ALARM" red LED lights up too.

- The "DEFAUT/ALARM" red LED lights up fixed when a motor overload is detected (this doesn't work



- Rarely will the two LEDs be lighted up fixed together. If the case, it means a software fault. Then endpoints must be reset by using the PROGRAMMATION mode
